

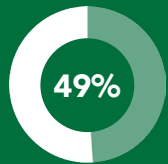

Tri-County Literacy Network is a non-profit organization that promotes life-long learning.

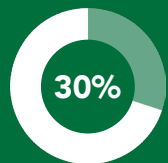
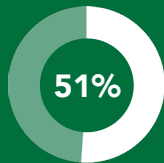

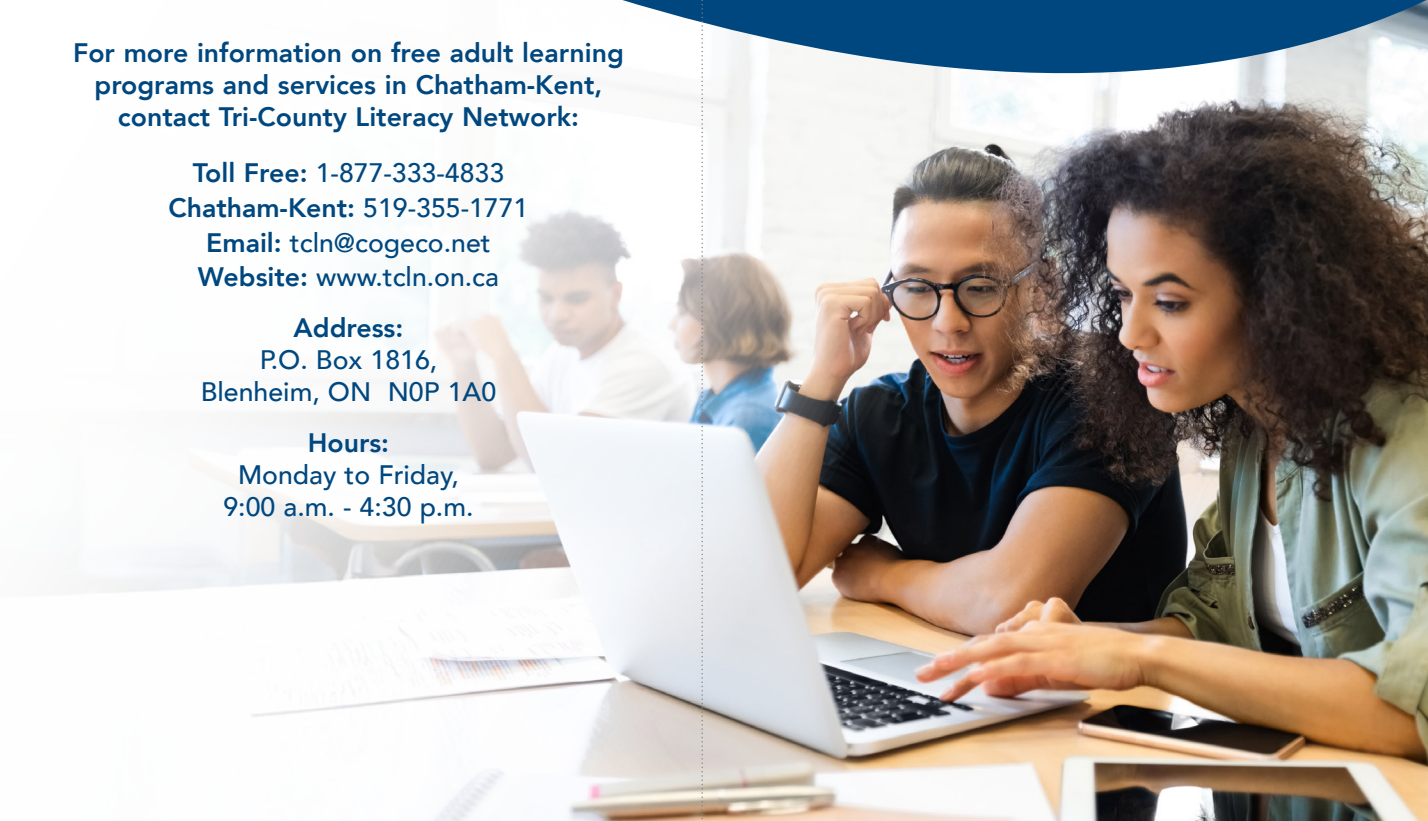
